





COUNCIL UPDATES

- •At the February 5, 2018 regular council meeting council directed administration to contact AECOM Engineering to provide cost to undertake a feasibility study to extend sewer services along 50 Ave west of 53 St.
- •The Town of Legal has entered into a contract with Box Clever Incorporated to develop a new Town website. Box Clever is an Edmonton based company who has extensive experience developing municipal websites across Western Canada. It's anticipated that the Town will have the new site ready by the end of June.
- •The Town of Legal has contracted Amanda Davis (2052900 Alberta Ltd) to manage and edit the content for the site. Amanda will be reaching out to local organizations for a synopsis of your organization goals and objectives. We encourage you all to be open and transparent with Amanda and to provide her with information in timely manner.
- •Town Council approved the purchase of a combination sewer flusher in the amount of \$165,000.00 to replace the current 1989 unit. Funding for the purchase will come from MSI Capital grants.

On February 7, 2018, the Town of Legal hosted a Town Hall Policing meeting with representatives of the RCMP, Alberta Solicitor General, and the Sturgeon Rural Crime Watch Association (SRCWA). Approximately 60 residents were in attendance for the event. Chief Superintendent District Officer Mehdizadeh began the presentation by emphasizing that Legal is a safe community with only 60 reported crimes for 2017. The RCMP presentation focused on two central topics – smart policing (problem focused and data driven within a framework of community partnerships) and hot spot policing (using statistical data to determine where high crime areas are). Sgt. Kendall emphasized that it is important for residents to report seemingly trivial crimes, such as minor or attempted thefts of personal items from vehicles. If crimes are not being reported, the RCMP cannot determine where the hotspots are. Knowing this information informs the RCMP of where to conduct more frequent patrols and concentrate their efforts. The SRCWA echoed the RCMP advice to residents about the importance of reporting any and all crimes. The SRCWA website will soon have tips to help residents understand how to prevent crime on their property. The SRCWA will also be partnering with businesses that have been victimized with the goal of blanketing Sturgeon County with timely information that creates a strong deterrent to criminals.


